Training providers have a duty to safeguard their apprentices. **Prevent** is about safeguarding apprentices to help keep them safe and within the law. With our Training partner Cheynes, we use **Side by Side**, the Prevent duty online modules which cover the following topics:

- Radicalisation and extremism
- Online safety
- What can you trust?
- British values.

Think Pink October for Breast Cancer Awareness Month



There are lots of ideas to raise awareness, turning the salon pink with balloons is one!

The Facts: The number of people being diagnosed with breast cancer is increasing but survival rates are improving, due to better breast awareness, earlier detection and targeted treatments.

Not all breast cancers show as a lump and not all breast lumps are breast cancer.

Less than 10% of breast cancer runs in families so having someone in your family with breast cancer doesn't necessarily mean your own risk is increased.

The Stats: This October around 4,000 people will be diagnosed with breast cancer.

Breast cancer is the 2nd biggest cause of death from cancer for UK women after lung cancer. There are an estimated 550,000 people living in the UK today have been diagnosed with breast cancer – that's about 1 in 50 women.

In women under 35, breast cancer is the second most commonly diagnosed cancer.

So this Pink October is a timely reminder to check yourself regularly, and get checked.
